

## **Human Rights Committee Report, June 2018.**

During the meeting of the IASSW board in Zagreb, at the end of January of this year (2018), I accept to support the human rights committee, after Vasilios Ioakimidis resigned from our board.

During this time I have been aware of the situation of and I have limited myself to reproduce petitions of social workers regarding their requests. Some in relation to what happened in Iran and the issue of Israel. I decided not to propose it to you, because of the sensitivity of the situations and because we do not have enough information.

Campaigns, pronouncements or petitions of different social work associations have been reproduced, the last one by the Latin American Association of Teaching and Research in Social Work - ALAETS -, the International Federation of Social Work for the Latin American region and the Caribbean - FITS ALC-, and the Latin American and Caribbean Committee of Social Work Organizations -COLACATS, for the situation of separation of children from immigrant families in the United States and the violation of human rights by the government led by Donald Trump.

In this regard, I would like to ask the joint board of Dublin to make a pronouncement on the treatment of immigrants in general to the United States and Europe, especially for the attitude assumed by Italy government, regard with the African immigrants I think it is very important to pronounce ourselves.

I must resume joint work with those who have offered to support the committee.
